SENATE AMENDMENT "1^A " to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to S.P. 948, L.D. 2217, "An Act to Strengthen the Maine Veterans' Homes with Increased and Ongoing Funding"

Amend the amendment by striking out everything after the title and inserting the following:

'Amend the bill by striking out the title and substituting the following:

'Resolve, to Require the Department of Health and Human Services to Amend Its MaineCare Reimbursement Rules to Provide Reimbursement to Veterans' Facilities on a Per Resident Basis'

Amend the bill by striking out everything after the title and inserting the following:

- 'Sec. 1. Department of Health and Human Services to amend MaineCare rules regarding veterans' facilities. Resolved: That the Department of Health and Human Services shall amend its rules in Chapter 101: MaineCare Benefits Manual, Chapter III, Section 67, Principles of Reimbursement for Nursing Facilities, and Section 97, Appendix C, Principles of Reimbursement for Medical and Remedial Service Facilities, as follows.
- 1. Per resident basis. The rules must provide that veterans' facilities are reimbursed on a per resident daily rate basis for services to residents covered under the United States Social Security Act, Title XIX at all Maine Veterans' Homes facilities at the locations required by the Maine Revised Statutes, Title 37-B, section 601, subsection 2. The rate calculation must result in reimbursement of the portion of the total allowable cost of operating each veterans' facility attributable to the provision of services to residents who receive MaineCare benefits.
- 2. Inflation adjustment. The rules must contain an annual inflation adjustment provision.
- 3. Calculation of per resident daily rate; limitation. Comparison data with other states' veterans' home programs and appropriate price indices may be used in deriving the per resident daily rate, as long as the application of comparison data and price indices does not reduce reimbursement below the MaineCare portion of total allowable costs as described in subsections 1 and 2.

Fiscal Detail and Notes

This amendment strikes the allocation for payment to the Maine Veterans' Homes to support ongoing operations and strikes the transfer from the General Fund to the Department of Health and Human Services, Nursing Facilities-MVH Other Special Revenue Funds account to fund the allocation.

The amendment includes General Fund appropriations to the Department of Health and Human Services of \$5,101,478 in fiscal year 2024-25 to ensure that Maine Veterans' Homes nursing facilities are reimbursed a per resident daily rate for services that include the total allowable cost of operating a veterans' home and it must also include an annual inflation adjustment provision. Federal Expenditures Fund allocations are included for the FMAP match and Other Special Revenue Funds allocations for the Service Provider and Nursing Facilities Tax.
