13 14 15	Amend the bill in section 14 in subsection 4 in paragraph B in subparagraph (3) in the last line (page 6, line 24 in L.D.) by striking out the following: "." and inserting the following: '-: and'
16 17	Amend the bill in section 14 in subsection 4 in paragraph B by inserting after subparagraph (3) the following:
18 19	'(4) Provide a copy to the court of the notification to the restricted person, including the date of notification.'
20 21	Amend the bill by relettering or renumbering any nonconsecutive Part letter or section number to read consecutively.

23 24 25	This amendment requires a law enforcement officer to provide to the court a copy of any notification of restriction under the State's so-called yellow flag law, which must include the date of notification.
