8 SENATE AMENDMENT "**A**" to S.P. 953, L.D. 2224, "An Act to Strengthen Public
9 Safety by Improving Maine's Firearm Laws and Mental Health System"

10 Amend the bill in section 14 in subsection 4 in paragraph B in subparagraph (2) in the
11 last line (page 6, line 22 in L.D.) by striking out the following: "and" and inserting the
12 following: **'and'**

13 Amend the bill in section 14 in subsection 4 in paragraph B in subparagraph (3) in the
14 last line (page 6, line 24 in L.D.) by striking out the following: "." and inserting the
15 following: **'.; and'**

16 Amend the bill in section 14 in subsection 4 in paragraph B by inserting after
17 subparagraph (3) the following:

18 '(4) Provide a copy to the court of the notification to the restricted person, including
19 the date of notification.'

20 Amend the bill by relettering or renumbering any nonconsecutive Part letter or section
21 number to read consecutively.

22 **SUMMARY**

23 This amendment requires a law enforcement officer to provide to the court a copy of
24 any notification of restriction under the State's so-called yellow flag law, which must
25 include the date of notification.
