2 3 4	Sec. 1. 29-A MRSA §2411, sub-§5, ¶ A, as amended by PL 2013, c. 389, §1 and affected by §7, is further amended by amending subparagraph (3), division (a), subdivision (i) to read:
5 6 7	(i) Was tested as Operated a motor vehicle while having an alcohol level of 0.15 grams or more of alcohol per 100 milliliters of blood or 210 liters of breath;
8	SUMMARY
9	This bill specifies that the mandatory minimum sentence of incarceration for a violation
10	of operating under the influence applies when the person has operated a motor vehicle while
11	having an alcohol level of 0.15 grams or more of alcohol per 100 milliliters of blood or 210
12	liters of breath. Current law applies the penalty if the person was tested as having an
13	alcohol level of 0.15 grams or more of alcohol per 100 milliliters of blood or 210 liters of
14	breath.
