Amend the amendment by striking out the title and inserting the following:

**'An Act to Provide Emergency One-time Relief from the Wild Blueberry Tax for  
13 Growers and to Continue Certain Limited-period Positions Throughout State  
14 Government'**

Amend the amendment by striking out all of section 2 and inserting the following:

16

**'Sec. 2. Continuation of limited-period positions.** Notwithstanding any  
17 provision of law to the contrary, all limited-period positions throughout State Government  
18 that are scheduled to expire during June 2024, are already funded through the end of fiscal  
19 year 2023-24 and are proposed to continue in fiscal year 2024-25 are authorized to continue  
20 until October 1, 2024.'

Amend the amendment by relettering or renumbering any nonconsecutive Part letter or  
22 section number to read consecutively.

**SUMMARY**

This amendment removes the appropriations and allocations section. The amendment  
25 provides that all limited-period positions throughout State Government that are scheduled  
26 to expire during June 2024, are already funded through the end of fiscal year 2023-24 and  
27 are proposed to continue in fiscal year 2024-25 are authorized to continue until October 1,  
28 2024.

This amendment removes the one-time General Fund appropriation of \$3,920 to the Department of Administrative Services, Bureau of Revenue Services in fiscal year 2024-25.
