SENATE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 1453, L.D. 2263, "An Act to Fund Military Sexual Trauma Liaison Positions at Community-based Organizations"

Amend the bill by striking out the title and substituting the following:

'An Act to Fund Military Sexual Trauma Victim Services at a Community-based Nonprofit Organization'

Amend the bill by striking out everything after the enacting clause and inserting the following:

'Sec. 1. Request for proposals. The Department of Health and Human Services shall, through a request for proposals process, award one-time funding to a community-based nonprofit organization that provides direct services, including housing, to female survivors of military sexual trauma.

Sec. 2. Appropriations and allocations. The following appropriations and allocations are made.

Purchased Social Services 0228**

Initiative: Provides a one-time appropriation to support victim services for female survivors of military sexual trauma through a community-based nonprofit organization.

Fiscal Detail and Notes

This amendment removes the \$140,000 ongoing General Fund appropriations for 2 military sexual trauma liaisons beginning in fiscal year 2024-25 and adds a one-time General Fund appropriation of \$70,000 in fiscal year 2024-25 to support victim services for female survivors of military sexual trauma through a community-based organization. It also adds language to the bill requiring the organization to be selected through a request for proposals process.
