SENATE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 1476, L.D. 2285, "Resolve, Directing the Department of Education to Establish the Commission to Study School Construction Policy and Funding"

Amend the resolve in section 2 by inserting after subsection 6 the following:

'Those members of the commission whose terms as Legislators expire at the end of the 131st Legislature may continue to serve as members of the commission until it submits its report pursuant to section 7.'

Amend the resolve by relettering or renumbering any nonconsecutive Part letter or section number to read consecutively.

SUMMARY

This amendment allows members of the Commission to Study School Construction Policy and Funding who are Legislators to continue to serve as members of the commission beyond the term of the 131st Legislature.
