COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to S.P. 32, L.D. 19, "An Act to Change the Definition of "Oversized ATV" in the Laws Governing the Registration of All-terrain Vehicles"

Amend the bill by striking out all of the emergency preamble.

Amend the bill in section 1 in subsection 5-B in the last line (page 1, line 23 in L.D.) by striking out the following: "2,500" and inserting the following: '2,950'

Amend the bill by striking out all of the emergency clause.

Amend the bill by relettering or renumbering any nonconsecutive Part letter or section number to read consecutively.

SUMMARY

This amendment removes the emergency preamble and emergency clause from the bill and increases the minimum weight of an oversized all-terrain vehicle from 2,000 to 2,950 pounds, rather than 2,500 pounds as in the bill.
