SENATE AMENDMENT "A" to S.P. 150, L.D. 384, "An Act to Prevent Student Homelessness"

Amend the bill by striking out all of section 2 and inserting the following:

'Sec. 2. Appropriations and allocations. The following appropriations and allocations are made.

EDUCATION, DEPARTMENT OF
School and Student Supports Z270

Initiative: Provides ongoing funds to help students avoid homelessness by providing liaisons designated pursuant to the federal McKinney-Vento Homeless Education Assistance Improvements Act of 2001 access to emergency financial assistance for the family of a student in an amount of up to \$750 per student.

Fiscal Detail and Notes

This amendment reduces the ongoing General Fund appropriations in the bill by \$1,375,000 per year beginning in fiscal year 2025-26.

As amended, this bill includes ongoing General Fund appropriations of \$125,000 per year beginning in fiscal year 2025-26 to the School and Student Supports program within the Department of Education to help students avoid homelessness by providing liaisons designated pursuant to the federal McKinney-Vento Homeless Education Assistance Improvements Act of 2001 access to emergency financial assistance for the family of a student in an amount of up to \$750 per student.
