SENATE AMENDMENT "A" to S.P. 266, L.D. 583, "An Act to Support Informed Community Self-determination in Emergency Medical Services Planning"

Amend the bill by striking out all of section 1 and inserting the following:

'Sec. 1. Appropriations and allocations. The following appropriations and allocations are made.

Initiative: Provides a one-time appropriation for the Maine Emergency Medical Services Community Grant Program.
