SENATE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 489, L.D. 747, "An Act to Provide Funds to Reduce Student Homelessness"

Amend the bill by striking out all of section 3 and inserting the following:

'Sec. 3. Appropriations and allocations. The following appropriations and allocations are made.

Initiative: Provides ongoing funds for rental assistance for homeless students in elementary school and secondary school.

Fiscal Detail and Notes

This amendment reduces the ongoing General Fund appropriations in the bill by \$1,875,000 per year beginning in fiscal year 2025-26.

As amended, this bill includes ongoing General Fund appropriations of \$125,000 per year beginning in fiscal year 2025-26 to the Maine State Housing Authority to provide rental assistance for homeless students in elementary school and secondary school.
