This amendment reduces the ongoing General Fund appropriations in the bill by \$1,875,000 per year beginning in fiscal year 2025-26.

As amended, this bill includes ongoing General Fund appropriations of \$125,000 per year beginning in fiscal year 2025-26 to the Maine State Housing Authority to provide rental assistance for homeless students in elementary school and secondary school.
