HOUSE AMENDMENT "A" to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 568,
L.D. 882, "An Act to Protect Communication with Providers of Critical Incident Stress
Management Peer Support"

Amend the amendment in section 5 in §4203 in subsection 3 in the first line (page 3,
line 20 in amendment) by inserting after the following: "law" the following: 'or in legal
proceeding'

Amend the amendment in section 5 in §4203 in subsection 3 in the 6th line (page 3,
line 25 in amendment) by inserting after the following: "others." the following: 'When the
physical or mental condition of an affected person is an issue in an action, suit or
proceeding or when a court in the exercise of sound discretion considers the disclosure
necessary to the proper administration of justice, information communicated to, or
otherwise learned by, a person in connection with the provision of critical incident stress
management or peer support is not privileged and disclosure may be required.'

Amend the amendment by relettering or renumbering any nonconsecutive Part letter or
section number to read consecutively.

SUMMARY

This amendment provides that information about the physical or mental condition of
an affected person is not confidential if that condition is an issue in a legal proceeding or a
court considers it necessary to the proper administration of justice.
