SENATE AMENDMENT "A" to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 935,  
L.D. 1426, "Resolve, to Expand Child Assertive Community Treatment"

Amend the amendment by striking out the first instructional paragraph and inserting the following:

'Amend the resolve in the emergency preamble by striking out all of the 6th paragraph (page 1, lines 12 to 15 in L.D.) and inserting the following:

'Whereas, this legislation needs to take effect as soon as possible in order to develop the pilot program required by this legislation that addresses the scarcity of child assertive community treatment teams and provides timely services to children with behavioral health challenges; and'

Amend the amendment by striking out all of section 1 and inserting the following:

**'Sec. 1. Child assertive community treatment team. Resolved:** That, by March 1, 2026, the Department of Health and Human Services shall issue a request for applications for a grant to establish a pilot program to develop one child assertive community treatment team to serve the Lewiston or Bangor geographic area. The request for applications must require the awardee of the grant to use workforce incentives designed to attract, train and retain child assertive community treatment staff. The department shall engage in a competitive process to determine the awardee. The term of the contract may not exceed 2 years.'

Amend the amendment by inserting before the 3rd instructional paragraph the following:

'Amend the resolve in section 2 in the 2nd line (page 1, line 29 in L.D.) by striking out the following: "programs" and inserting the following: 'program'

Amend the resolve in section 2 in the last line (page 1, line 32 in L.D.) by striking out the following: "programs" and inserting the following: 'program'

Amend the amendment by striking out all of section 3 and inserting the following:

**'Sec. 3. Appropriations and allocations. Resolved:** That the following appropriations and allocations are made.

**Fiscal Detail and Notes**

The amendment delays the implementation of the two-year pilot program by one year and reduces the number of pilot program sites from two to one. This eliminates General Fund appropriations in fiscal year 2025-26 and reduces General Fund appropriations in fiscal year 2026-27 by 50%. Federal Expenditures Fund and Federal Block Grant Fund allocations are adjusted accordingly.
