HOUSE AMENDMENT "A" to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 991,  
9 L.D. 1507, "An Act to Require General Public Notification of Oil Terminal Facility  
10 Transfer Activities"

Amend the amendment in section 1 in paragraph F in subparagraph (1) in the last line  
12 (page 1, line 21 in amendment) by striking out the following: "100 feet" and inserting the  
13 following: "200 feet"

14

Amend the amendment by relettering or renumbering any nonconsecutive Part letter or  
15 section number to read consecutively.

**SUMMARY**

This amendment requires warning signs to be installed at intervals no greater than 200  
18 feet instead of no greater than 100 feet as in Committee Amendment "A."
