SENATE AMENDMENT "A" to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to S.P. 676,  
L.D. 1730, "An Act Regarding the Beneficial Electrification Policy of the State"

Amend the amendment in section 1 in §3475 in subsection 1 in paragraph A in  
subparagraph (1) in the 4th line (page 1, line 25 in amendment) by striking out the  
following: "Safety"

Amend the amendment in section 1 in §3475 in subsection 1 in paragraph A by striking  
out all of subparagraph (3) (page 1, lines 29 to 31 in amendment) and inserting the  
following:

'(3) Configured in accordance with the National Electrical Code that is adopted by  
rule by the Electricians' Examining Board, established in Title 5, section 12004-A,  
subsection 13.'

Amend the amendment in section 1 in §3475 in subsection 1 in paragraph D in  
subparagraph (1) in the 4th and 5th lines (page 2, lines 15 and 16 in amendment) by striking  
out the following: "Technical Building Codes and Standards Board, established in Title 5,  
section 12004-G, subsection 5-A" and inserting the following: 'Electricians' Examining  
Board, established in Title 5, section 12004-A, subsection 13'

Amend the amendment by relettering or renumbering any nonconsecutive Part letter or  
section number to read consecutively.

**SUMMARY**

This amendment:

1. Changes the code with which an eligible system must comply to the National  
Electrical Code; and

2. Changes the entity adopting by rule the National Electrical Code to the Electricians'  
Examining Board.
