1 Emergency preamble. Whereas, acts and resolves of the Legislature do not 2 become effective until 90 days after adjournment unless enacted as emergencies; and 3 Whereas, the 90-day period may not terminate until after the beginning of the next 4 fiscal year; and 5 Whereas, emergency alert messaging on the statewide radio network operated by the Maine Public Broadcasting Corporation benefits Maine residents in all 16 counties, and 6 state funding in this legislation will enable localization of public safety information and 7 8 emergency alert messaging on the statewide radio network; and 9 Whereas, in the judgment of the Legislature, these facts create an emergency within the meaning of the Constitution of Maine and require the following legislation as 10 immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety; now, 11 12 therefore. Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows: 13 14 Sec. 1. Appropriations and allocations. The following appropriations and allocations are made. 15 PUBLIC BROADCASTING CORPORATION, MAINE 16 17 **Maine Public Broadcasting Corporation 0033** Initiative: Provides one-time funds for broadcast infrastructure equipment to enable 18 localization of public safety information and emergency alert messaging on the statewide 19 radio network operated by the Maine Public Broadcasting Corporation. 20 21 **GENERAL FUND** 2026-27 2025-26 22 All Other \$600,000 \$0 23 24 \$600,000 \$0 GENERAL FUND TOTAL 25 **Emergency clause.** In view of the emergency cited in the preamble, this legislation 26 takes effect when approved. 27 **SUMMARY** 28 This bill provides one-time funds for broadcast infrastructure equipment to enable 29 localization of public safety information and emergency alert messaging on the statewide

radio network operated by the Maine Public Broadcasting Corporation.

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
