2 3	Sec. 1. 12 MRSA §6601, sub-§5, as amended by PL 2017, c. 284, Pt. EEEEE, §14, is further amended to read:
4 5	5. License fee. Except as provided in subsection subsections 5-A and 5-B, the fee for a commercial shellfish license is \$58.25.
6 7	Sec. 2. 12 MRSA §6601, sub-§5-A, as amended by PL 2017, c. 284, Pt. EEEEE, §15, is further amended to read:
8 9 10	5-A. Exception; age. The fee for a commercial shellfish license for applicants 70 years of age or older and applicants under 18 years of age is \$67, which must be deposited in the Shellfish Fund established under section 6651.
11	Sec. 3. 12 MRSA §6601, sub-§5-B is enacted to read:
12 13 14	<u>5-B. Exception; veterans.</u> The department shall offer a 50% discount on the applicable license fee required under subsection 5 or 5-A to an applicant who is a veteran of the United States Armed Forces and who was honorably discharged.
15	Sec. 4. Effective date. This Act takes effect January 1, 2027.
