## 1 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows: 2 **Sec. 1. 29-A MRSA §2054, sub-§1, ¶K** is enacted to read: 3 K. "Variable-message sign" means a traffic control device on which a message can be 4 displayed and changed manually, electrically, mechanically or electromechanically to 5 provide information about traffic congestion, traffic accidents, maintenance operations, adverse weather conditions, roadway conditions, organized events or other necessary 6 7 information. 8 Sec. 2. 29-A MRSA §2054, sub-§12 is enacted to read: 9 12. Variable-message signs. The operator of an authorized public service vehicle may use a variable-message sign on the authorized public service vehicle while the vehicle 10 is stationary and engaged in roadside repair, loading or unloading a vehicle, vehicle 11 12 recovery or general traffic control. The Commissioner of Public Safety may adopt rules as 13 necessary for the purpose of implementing this subsection. Rules adopted pursuant to this 14 subsection are routine technical rules as defined in Title 5, chapter 375, subchapter 2-A. 15 **SUMMARY** 16 This bill allows the operator of an authorized public service vehicle to use a variablemessage sign on the authorized public service vehicle while the vehicle is stationary and 17

engaged in roadside repair, loading or unloading a vehicle, vehicle recovery or general
