Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:

Sec. 1. 5 MRSA §17851-A, sub-§1, ¶N, as amended by PL 2021, c. 398, Pt. KKK, §1 and c. 474, §2, is further amended to read:

N. Emergency communications director, emergency communications specialists, emergency communications specialist - leads, emergency communications specialist - supervisors, emergency communications specialist - programs coordinator and emergency dispatch system administrators in the employment of the Department of Public Safety on July 1, 2020 who elect to participate in the 1998 Special Plan or hired thereafter;

SUMMARY

This bill modifies service retirement provisions by adding the renamed position of programs coordinator and the emergency communications director to the 1998 Special Plan to enable a qualified individual to accept this role without losing existing retirement benefits due to the change of title.
