**Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:**

**Sec. 1. 25 MRSA §1504, first ¶**, as amended by PL 1985, c. 785, Pt. B, §109, is further amended to read:

The Governor shall determine the salary of the chief and, the deputy chief and majors. The compensation of the other members of the State Police ~~shall be is~~ determined under the Civil Service Law.

## SUMMARY

This bill requires the Governor to determine the salaries of majors in the Department of Public Safety, Maine State Police.
