1 receive a 30-day eviction notice. The resolve establishes an exception that allows the
2 department, upon the provider's request and under certain circumstances specified in the
3 resolve, to extend the 120-day period by increments of 60 days, up to 2 extensions, except
4 that a remaining resident member may be granted more than 2 extensions if that member
5 has lived at the member's current address for at least 5 years.
