COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to S.P. 835, L.D. 2136, "An Act to Support Victims of Trafficking in Maine in Response to Federal Funding Cuts"

Amend the bill by inserting before section 1 the following:

'Sec. 1. Department of Health and Human Services to provide funding to support Preble Street anti-trafficking program. The Department of Health and Human Services, notwithstanding the Maine Revised Statutes, Title 5, section 1825-B, shall provide funds to support the Preble Street anti-trafficking program.'

Amend the bill by relettering or renumbering any nonconsecutive Part letter or section number to read consecutively.

SUMMARY

This amendment requires the Department of Health and Human Services to use the appropriated funds to support Preble Street's anti-trafficking program.
