COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 1460, L.D. 2172, "Resolve, Regarding Legislative Review of Portions of Chapter 33: Rule Governing Physical Restraint and Seclusion, a Major Substantive Rule of the Department of Education, State Board of Education"

Amend the resolve in section 1 in the 5th line (page 1, line 18 in L.D.) by inserting after the following: "is" the following: 'not'

Amend the resolve by relettering or renumbering any nonconsecutive Part letter or section number to read consecutively.
