## STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND SIXTY-EIGHT.

AN ACT authorizing Drew plantation to raise money for certain purposes.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

- SECTION 1. All the powers which towns now have,
- 2 to raise and expend money for the purpose of making
- 3 and repairing roads, building bridges, and to pay offi-
- 4 cers and agents, are hereby extended to Drew planta-
- 5 tion, in the county of Penobscot.
  - Sect. 2. The present organization of said plantation
- 2 is hereby declared legal; and said plantation may in
- 3 March next, and annually thereafter, choose a clerk,
- 4 assessors, treasurer, collector and highway surveyors,
- 5 who shall have the same powers and duties relative to

- 6 the assessment, collection and expenditure of money
- 7 for the purposes herein indicated, that the officers in
- 8 towns have.

Sect. 3. This act shall take effect when approved.
