## STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND SIXTY-EIGHT.

AN ACT to amend section nineteen of chapter ninety-one of the revised statutes, relating to liens on logs and lumber.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

Section nineteen of chapter ninety-one of the revised 2 statutes is hereby amended in the first line thereof by 3 adding the word "rafting" after the word "hauling," 4 so that the section, as amended, will read as follows: 5 "A person who labors at cutting, hauling, rafting, or 6 driving logs or lumber, shall have a lien thereon for 7 the amount due for his personal services, except liens 8 reserved to the States of Maine and Massachusetts, to

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9 continue for sixty days after the logs or lumber arrive10 at the place of destination for sale or manufacture,11 and be enforced by attachment."
