STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND SIXTY-EIGHT.

AN ACT to provide for the taxation of costs.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

- Section 1. In all actions now pending, or which
- 2 may be hereafter commenced in the supreme judicial
- 3 court, in which a nonsuit or default shall be entered,
- 4 a verdict rendered, or a report of referees accepted,
- 5 either party shall upon application to the court, have
- 6 the costs recoverable in said action taxed by the clerk
- 7 and passed upon by the court before the adjournment
- 8 of the term.
 - SECT. 2. Either party who may be aggrieved by the
- 2 allowance or disallowance of costs by the presiding
- 3 judge, shall have the right to file exceptions thereto;

- 4 said exceptions to be heard before the law court next
- 5 held in the district in which said exceptions may be
- 6 filed.
 - SECT. 3. If neither party shall request an adjudica-
- 2 tion upon the question of costs at the term when the
- 3 nonsuit, default, verdict, or acceptance of report of
- 4 referees is entered, said hearing may be had after the
- 5 adjournment of said court before the clerk, and his
- 6 decision shall be final.
- Sect. 4. This act shall take effect from and after 2 its approval by the governer.
