STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND SIXTY-EIGHT.

AN ACT prohibiting the selectmen of towns from being collectors of taxes.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows :

SECTION 1. Any person holding the office of a selectman in any town in this state shall not at the same time be a collector of taxes in such town.

SECT. 2. This act shall take effect when approved.
