## STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND SIXTY-EIGHT.

AN ACT to amend chapter one hundred and sixteen of the public laws of eighteen hundred and sixty-seven, relating to the appointment of stenographers in the supreme judicial court.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

- SECTION 1. The first section of chapter one hundred
- 2 and sixteen of the public laws of the year eighteen
- 3 hundred and sixty-seven, is hereby amended by insert-
- 4 ing in the seventh line of said section, after the word
- 5 "court," the words, "including the charge of the
- 6 judge," so that the clause in said section containing
- 7 said words shall read as follows:—And under the di-
- 8 rection of the presiding justice it shall be his duty to

- 9 take full notes of all oral testimony and other proceed-
- 10 ings in the trial of causes in said court including the
- 11 charge of the judge," and furnish for the use of the
- 12 court a fair legible long-hand copy of so much of his
- 13 notes as the presiding justice shall direct.

SECT. 2. This act shall take effect when approved.
