STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND SIXTY-EIGHT.

AN ACT to amend chapter one hundred and sixteen of the public laws of eighteen hundred and sixty-seven, relating to the appointment of stenographers in the supreme judicial court.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows :

SECTION 1. The first section of chapter one hundred 2 and sixteen of the public laws of the year eighteen 3 hundred and sixty-seven, is hereby amended by insert- 4 ing in the seventh line of said section, after the word 5 "court," the words, "including the charge of the 6 judge," so that the clause in said section containing 7 said words shall read as follows :—And under the di- 8 rection of the presiding justice it shall be his duty to

9 take full notes of all oral testimony and other proceed-
10 ings in the trial of causes in said court including the
11 charge of the judge," and furnish for the use of the
12 court a fair legible long-hand copy of so much of his
13 notes as the presiding justice shall direct.

SECT. 2. This act shall take effect when approved.
