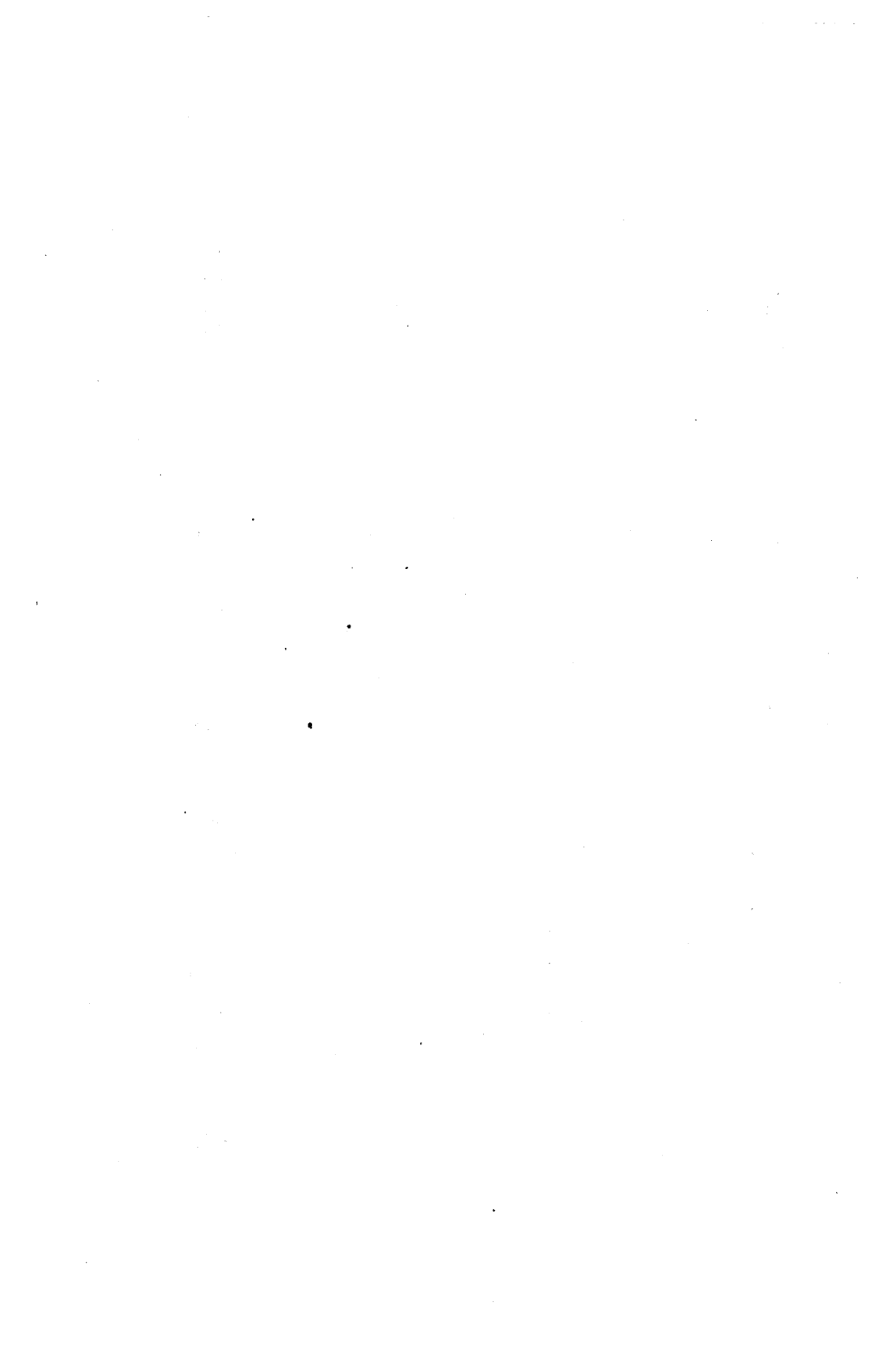
AN ACT to amend section fourteen of chapter seventy-  
seven of the revised statutes.

---

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives  
in Legislature assembled, as follows :*

SECTION 1. Section fourteen of chapter seventy-  
2 seven of the revised statutes is hereby amended by  
3 adding the following words :—“ But when any of the  
4 justices do not sit in a case by reason of interest, or  
5 having been counsel, or any disqualifying cause, then  
6 the concurrence of a majority of the remaining mem-  
7 bers of the court shall be sufficient to determine such  
8 case.”

SECT. 2. This act shall take effect when approved.
