## STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND SIXTY-EIGHT.

AN ACT to amend section two of chapter one hundred and thirty-eight of the revised statutes.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

- SECTION 1. Section two of chapter one hundred and
- 2 thirty-eight of the revised statutes is hereby amended
- 3 by striking out the fourth line and inserting the follow-
- 4 ing words: "two weeks' notice in any newspaper pub-
- 5 lished in said county"; so that the first clause in said
- 6 section shall read as follows: "On all petitions to the
- 7 governor for pardon or commutation of sentence, writ-
- 8 ten notice thereof shall be given to the county attorney
- 9 for the county where the case was tried, and two
- 10 weeks' notice in any newspaper published in said
- 11 county."

SECT. 2. This act shall take effect when approved.
