STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND SIXTY-EIGHT.

AN ACT to amend section forty-nine, chapter eighty-one of the revised statutes.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

- Section 1. Section forty-nine of chapter eighty-one
- 2 of the revised statutes is hereby amended by adding
- 3 the words, "the appraisers may be sworn by the offi-
- 4 cer, without fee, or by a justice of the peace or trial
- 5 justice," so that the section as amended shall read as
- 6 follows:
- 7 Section 49. The appraisers shall be appointed, one
- 8 by the creditor, one by the debtor, and one by the
- 9 officer; and if the creditor or debtor neglects to ap-
- 10 point one, the officer shall appoint one in his behalf.

- 11 The appraisers may be sworn by the officer without
- 12 fee or by a justice of the peace or trial justice.
 - Sect. 2. This act shall take effect when approved.
