IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND SIXTY-EIGHT.

AN ACT to amend section forty-nine, chapter eighty-one of the revised statutes.

---

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows :*

SECTION 1. Section forty-nine of chapter eighty-one of the revised statutes is hereby amended by adding the words, “the appraisers may be sworn by the officer, without fee, or by a justice of the peace or trial justice,” so that the section as amended shall read as follows :

7 *Section 49.* The appraisers shall be appointed, one  
8 by the creditor, one by the debtor, and one by the  
9 officer ; and if the creditor or debtor neglects to ap-  
10 point one, the officer shall appoint one in his behalf.

11 The appraisers may be sworn by the officer without

12 fee or by a justice of the peace or trial justice.

SECT. 2. This act shall take effect when approved.
