STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND SIXTY-EIGHT.

AN ACT regulating the duties of road commissioners and highway surveyors.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows :

SECTION 1. It shall be the duty of road commissioners of cities, highway surveyors of towns, and organized plantations in this state, to go over their several highway districts, or cause it to be done by others, in the months of April, May, June, August, September, October and November, in each year, and remove the loose obstructions to the public travel.

SECT. 2. Any road commissioner or highway surveyor neglecting to comply with the provisions in section one of this act, shall be liable to a penalty of

4 five dollars, which may be recovered by complaint,
5 one half to the use of the county where such commis-
6 sioners or surveyors resides, and one half to the com-
7 plainant.

SECT. 3. This act shall take effect when approved.
