AN ACT in relation to bills in equity brought to redeem mortgages given by railroad corporations.

---

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows :*

In bills in equity brought to redeem mortgages given  
2 by railroad corporations to secure their bonds or other  
3 indebtedness, it shall not be necessary to allege or  
4 prove a tender of the amount due thereon ; but an  
5 averment therein that the complainants are ready and  
6 willing to redeem upon accounts rendered shall be suf-  
7 ficient to authorize the maintenance of such bill if said  
8 bill is otherwise maintainable.
