## STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND SIXTY-EIGHT.

AN ACT in relation to bills in equity brought to redeem mortgages given by railroad corporations.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

In bills in equity brought to redeem mortgages given

- 2 by railroad corporations to secure their bonds or other
- 3 indebtedness, it shall not be necessary to allege or
- 4 prove a tender of the amount due thereon; but an
- 5 averment therein that the complainants are ready and
- 6 willing to redeem upon accounts rendered shall be suf-
- 7 ficient to authorize the maintenance of such bill if said
- 8 bill is otherwise maintainable.
