STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND SIXTY-EIGHT.

AN ACT to increase the pay of the county commissioners of Penobscot county.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows :

SECTION 1. Instead of the compensation now established by law, each county commissioner of the county of Penobscot shall receive three dollars a day, and in that proportion for part of a day, while actually employed in the service of the county, including the time necessarily spent in making drafts or other labor, and exclusive of time spent in travelling, for which he shall be allowed twelve cents a mile for the distance actually travelled. His account shall specify the kind of service performed each day or part of a day. They

11 are not to be allowed for service or travel on more than
12 one petition or case at the same time, or for any addi-
13 tional trouble or expense of any kind.

SECT. 2. This act shall take effect from and after
2 the first day of January, in the year eighteen hundred
3 and sixty-eight.
