## STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND SIXTY-EIGHT.

AN ACT to increase the pay of the county commissioners of Penobscot county.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

- Section 1. Instead of the compensation now estab-
- 2 lished by law, each county commissioner of the county
- 3 of Penobscot shall receive three dollars a day, and in
- 4 that proportion for part of a day, while actually em-
- 5 ployed in the service of the county, including the time
- 6 necessarily spent in making drafts or other labor, and
- 7 exclusive of time spent in travelling, for which he
- 8 shall be allowed twelve cents a mile for the distance
- 9 actually travelled. His account shall specify the kind
- 10 of service performed each day or part of a day. They

- 11 are not to be allowed for service or travel on more than
- 12 one petition or case at the same time, or for any addi-
- 13 tional trouble or expense of any kind.
  - Sect. 2. This act shall take effect from and after
  - 2 the first day of January, in the year eighteen hundred
  - 3 and sixty-eight.
