## STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND SIXTY-EIGHT.

AN ACT providing for the amendment of the returns of deceased officers on certain civil processes.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

When any deputy sheriff who has made service of,

- 2 and returned any writ, execution, or other process, is
- 3 dead, the court on satisfactory proof of the facts may
- 4 allow the sheriff under whom such deputy acted, and
- 5 in case of his death, any deputy of the same sheriff, in
- 6 commission at the time of the service of such writ,
- 7 execution, or other process, to amend the return there-
- 8 of in the same manner and with the same effect as if
- 9 amended by the officer who made such service and re-
- 10 turn; provided the rights of third parties shall not be
- 11 affected thereby.
