AN ACT to amend chapter forty-seven of the revised statutes.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

Chapter forty-seven of the revised statutes is hereby

- 2 amended by adding thereto the following:
- 3 "Sect. 89. Nothing contained in this chapter shall
- 4 be construed to defeat the right of set-off where there
- 5 are mutual demands outstanding between any banking
- 6 corporation and any debtor thereof, notwithstanding
- 7 such claim in set-off may not have been laid before the
- 8 receivers of such corporation for examination and al-
- 9 lowance."
