STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND SIXTY-EIGHT.

AN ACT to define the duties of the superintendent of public buildings and to establish his salary.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

- Section 1. The duties of the superintendent of pub-
- 2 lic buildings shall be for the entire year the same as
- 3 prescribed for the recess of the legislature by a resolve
- 4 approved March twenty-fifth, eighteen hundred and
- 5 thirty-seven, and in addition thereto the governor and
- 6 council may require him to perform any other duties
- 7 from time to time that the public interest may require,
- 8 which he shall perform without extra compensation.
- 9 He shall receive in full for all his services the sum of
- 10 one thousand dollars for each year, payable quarterly,

- 11 and shall have no other perquisite or fee either in
- 12 money or property connected with his employment.
 - SECT. 2. Chapter thirty-seven of the public laws of
 - 2 the year eighteen hundred and sixty-six is hereby
 - 3 repealed.
 - SECT. 3. This act shall take effect when approved.
