## STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND SIXTY-EIGHT.

AN ACT to amend section twenty of chapter seventyseven of the revised statutes.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

- Section twenty of chapter seventy-seven of the re-
- 2 vised statutes is hereby amended by inserting after the
- 3 word "reception" in the second line of said section,
- 4 the words "which shall be regarded as the day of
- 5 the rendition of judgment"; so that said section as
- 6 amended shall read as follows:
- 7 "SECT. 20. The clerk of a county, by virtue of a
- 8 certificate provided for in this chapter, stating the day
- 9 of its reception, which shall be regarded as the day of
- 10 the rendition of judgment, shall enter judgment as of

- 11 the preceding term, and execution may issue as of that
- 12 term; but all attachments then in force continue to be
- 13 valid until thirty days after the next term in that
- **14** county."
