IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND SIXTY-EIGHT.

AN ACT to amend section twenty of chapter seventy-seven of the revised statutes.

---

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows :*

Section twenty of chapter seventy-seven of the revised statutes is hereby amended by inserting after the word "reception" in the second line of said section, the words "which shall be regarded as the day of the rendition of judgment"; so that said section as amended shall read as follows :

7 "SECT. 20. The clerk of a county, by virtue of a  
8 certificate provided for in this chapter, stating the day  
9 of its reception, which shall be regarded as the day of  
10 the rendition of judgment, shall enter judgment as of

11 the preceding term, and execution may issue as of that  
12 term ; but all attachments then in force continue to be  
13 valid until thirty days after the next term in that  
14 county.”
