## STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND SIXTY-EIGHT.

AN ACT to regulate the sale of lobsters by weight instead of count.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

- SECTION 1. Hereafter lobsters shall be sold by 2 weight instead of count.
  - SECT. 2. If any person shall violate the provisions
- 2 of this act, he shall forfeit for each offence the sum of
- 3 five dollars, to be recovered by complaint or action of
- 4 debt, one half to the town where the offence is com-
- 5 mitted and one half to the person suing therefor.
  - SECT. 3. This act shall take effect when approved.
