STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND SIXTY-EIGHT.

AN ACT to amend chapter one hundred and seven, section eight of the revised statutes, relating to depositions.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

SECTION 1. Section eight of chapter one hundred and seven of the revised statutes, is hereby amended, by striking out the words "one day" in the fourth line thereof and inserting instead the words "twenty-four hours," so that the second clause in said section shall read as follows: "The adverse party shall be allowed not less than at the rate of twenty-four hours, Sundays excepted, for every twenty miles travel from his usual place of abode to the place of caption, be-

10 tween the service of notice and time appointed for
11 taking the deposition.”

SECT. 2. This act shall take effect when approved.
