## STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND SIXTY-EIGHT.

AN ACT to amend chapter three hundred and twenty-one of the laws of eighteen hundred and sixty five relating to railroads.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

Section one of chapter three hundred and twenty-one 2 of the public laws of the year eighteen hundred and 3 sixty-five is hereby amended, so that the section as 4 amended shall read as follows :—A railroad corpora-5 tion may take and hold real estate for depot purposes 6 and for all necessary tracks or side tracks, and when 7 the parties interested do not consent thereto, and can-8 not agree upon other persons to determine the ques-9 tion of necessity and the extent thereof, the said cor-

10 poration may make application to the railroad com-11 missioners of this state to view the premises and 12 determine whether, and how much of said estate is 13 necessary for the reasonable accommodation of the 14 traffic and appropriate business of the said corpora-15 tion.
