STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND SIXTY-EIGHT.

AN ACT to amend section thirty-seven of chapter eighty-one of the revised statutes.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows :

Section thirty-seven of chapter eighty-one of the
2 revised statutes is hereby amended, by striking out
3 the words "five hundred" in the last clause of said
4 section and inserting the words "one thousand," so
5 that said clause as amended shall read as follows:—
6 "Also a lot of land and dwelling-house and outbuild-
7 ings thereon, or so much thereof as does not exceed
8 one thousand dollars in value, the property of a house-
9 holder in actual possession thereof not the owner of a

10 lot purchased of the state as aforesaid, shall be ex-
11 empted from attachment or levy of any execution, as
12 hereinafter provided."
