AN ACT relating to evidence.

---

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives  
in Legislature assembled, as follows :*

SECTION 1. In the trial of any action where the  
2 executor or administrator of a person deceased is a  
3 party, the adverse party, if nominal merely, and he  
4 has no interest in the subject matter of the suit, and  
5 had parted with his interest during the lifetime of  
6 such deceased person, shall not be excluded from  
7 testifying as a witness, if called by either party.

SECT. 2. This act shall take effect when approved.
