IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND SIXTY-EIGHT.

AN ACT relating to evidence.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

- Section 1. In the trial of any action where the
- 2 executor or administrator of a person deceased is a
- 3 party, the adverse party, if nominal merely, and he
- 4 has no interest in the subject matter of the suit, and
- 5 had parted with his interest during the lifetime of
- 6 such deceased person, shall not be excluded from
- 7 testifying as a witness, if called by either party.
 - SECT. 2. This act shall take effect when approved.
